Bush Trackers is an environmental education project designed to engage more children and their families with the bush, encouraging children to experience the bush on their own terms, through their own eyes and to allow them to share with others, the stories of their experiences in the bush.

Bush Trackers are beautifully designed, delightfully authentic double-sided A3 guides which allow families to discover and explore the bush from a kid's perspective.

Bush Trackers focus on features which kids love like caves and creeks, trees to climb, animals to be seen etc. Bush Trackers Guides include tips and anecdotes about adventures to be had along the way.

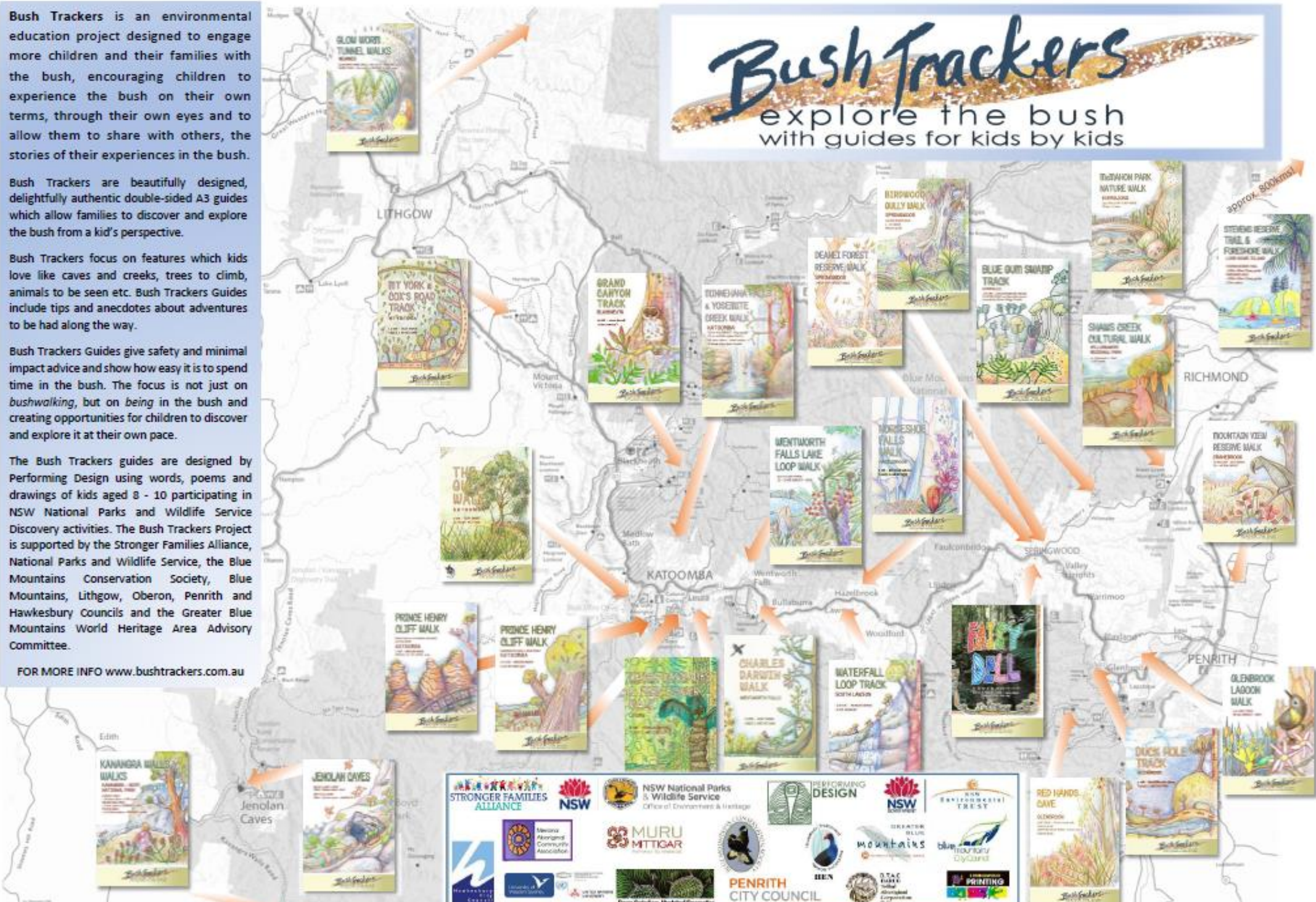
Bush Trackers Guides give safety and minimal impact advice and show how easy it is to spend time in the bush. The focus is not just on bushwalking, but on being in the bush and creating opportunities for children to discover and explore it at their own pace.

The Bush Trackers guides are designed by Performing Design using words, poems and drawings of kids aged 8 - 10 participating in NSW National Parks and Wildlife Service Discovery activities.
